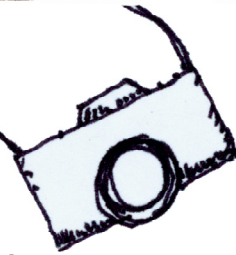

Animals in Gray



Today we are going to photograph our pets. If you don't have a pet and can't borrow one, you can use a person or, if that isn't possible, shoot your feet!

This is a Black and White assignment so the first thing is to figure out how to set your camera. Dig out your owner's manual and look up "Black and White mode." This is usually in a menu called "film mode" or "color effect." If you can't find it, google: "**your camera's make and model** black and white mode"

Set the picture-taking mode to "kids and pets" or "sports" or something similar.

Now chase your pet around taking pictures the whole time. Don't be afraid to waste "film," just keep snapping away. Even after you think you have a good shot, keep shooting! You should have no less than 50 shots.
