You may use pencil or pen (but if you use a pencil, don't spend too much — or any — time erasing). You should look at your "branch" MORE OFTEN than you look at your paper. Keep your hand very loose and "sketchy."



Again, don't worry too much about whether your branch is accurately drawn; just spend your energy looking at your subject and recording what you see.
