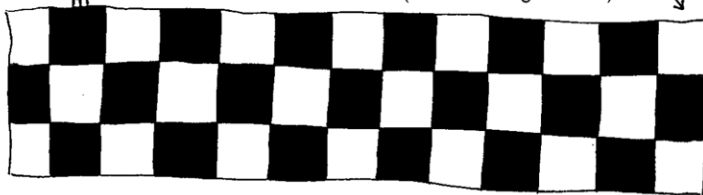
IT'S **SILLY** SATURDAY!

HOUSECLEANING DAY!

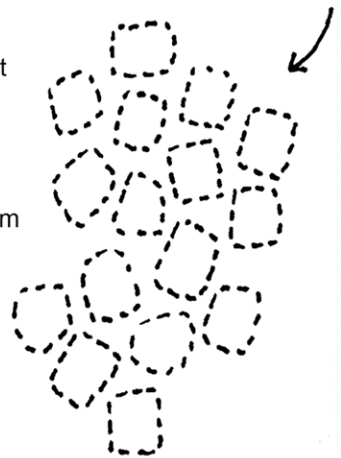


DANCE
