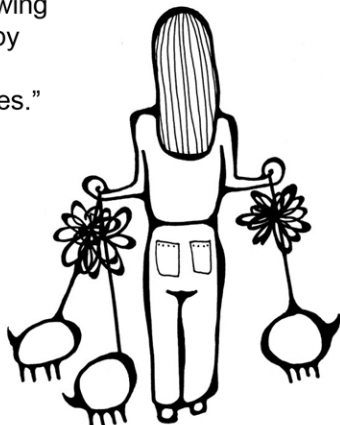
TAKE NOTES

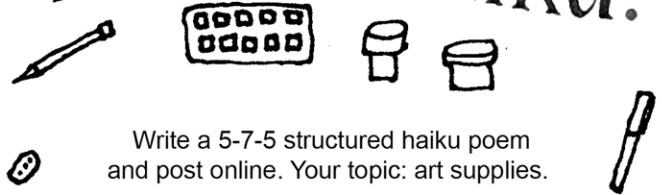
EXTRA CREDIT
